

Driving Instructions to Ferries and Egmont

(Print this...and take it with you!!)

Google Maps is confusing...instead, read this once you're through the City of Vancouver!

From Lion's Gate Bridge you can either -

1. a) follow signs for Ferries: stay left, go over Capilano River and take immediate right merge onto Taylor Way. At top of hill turn left onto Hwy 99/TransCanada 1 westbound.
b) follow Google Maps suggestion: turn right off bridge to North Vancouver, take first left, go up Capilano Road, under bridge and then right onto Hwy 99 westbound.
2. Now continue on Hwy 99 westbound for approximately 10-15 minutes.
3. As you pass Exit 4, Caulfield, get into the right lane.

This next part is where many people get confused as the signposting is awful and there are three different exits almost stacked on top of each other!
4. So, ignore reading confusing signs and stay in the FAR RIGHT LANE until you get to the tollbooths, merging into lanes designated "Langdale".

**If you mistakenly do not stay to the extreme right and you land up going North towards Whistler...take the first opportunity to U-turn and return towards Vancouver...and follow the following instructions!*

**If you end up in Horseshoe Bay Village proper, you will not be able to pass the tollbooths and go to the ferries...return to the Hwy going south east towards Vancouver and follow the following instructions!*

From Ferry Terminal if coming off Nanaimo or Bowen Island ferry (do NOT go into Horseshoe Bay Village...you must get back in lineup from the tollbooths) -or- if you got lost (see above) -

1. Take Hwy 99 South East towards Vancouver.
2. Exit at Caulfield, Exit 4.
3. Turn left over bridge, turn right on other side of this overpass, turn right again to merge onto Hwy 99 NorthWest. Keep in right hand lane.
4. Ignore reading confusing signs, stay in FAR RIGHT LANE until you get to the tollbooths, merging into lanes designated "Langdale".

Driving time from Horseshoe Bay Village or from the Terminal back to the tollbooth: approximately 10 minutes.

The only other confusing part may be as you are coming through the town of Sechelt. Follow the curve of the highway to the left, following the S-bend along Teredo Road. If you go straight ahead, you'll end up on the wrong side of the Coast in Porpoise Bay!
